

Obtaining a Judge from USA or DVG

USA policy for obtaining a VPG /IPO judge:

You must contact and send a letter of request to the USA DOJ Mark Przybylski. The policy states that the Regional Director needs to be contacted first BUT if your club is NOT a USA club please direct your requests to Mr. Przybylski.

Copied from the USA website:

"Clubs wishing to schedule any of these individuals to judge may contact them directly /for availability only/. USA Judges *must* be secured by contacting your Regional Director <../clubs/index.htm>, who in turn will contact the Director of Judges, Mark Przybylski <<mailto:dojusamark@aol.com> </group/awdfdelegates/post?postID= -- YlqSWvewEcXR9I1LY88nWhHxIGOkI7dL3Zd3FXRpAgiG9I62e96BRB_Gbmzjmx7vQ6yIIIIMKp>>.

This may be accomplished initially by phone, but finalization of all assignments must be in writing (Club to Regional Director to Director of Judges)."

DVG policy for securing judges :

When asking for a working VPG judge from DVG:

AWDF organizations wishing to obtain a DVG judge for a trial, all applications and requests must be sent to the LV/DVG America chief of judges, Hartmut Beckmann. By DVG/Germany rules, no judge can be assigned or accept an assignment to a trial that the application has not gone through the Landesverband chief of judges, whether that's here or in Germany.
